Text

Please write in plain English, and use Australian spellings. Include project title, participants, partners (eg funding or institution), location and date/year.

OHV may edit your project profile, and if so will send it back to you for approval/correction before posting it on the website.

Word count

If your submission includes multimedia: up to 200 words

If your submission includes only still images: up to 500 words

Technical Specifications

Still Images

Please include up to 4 high-resolution images, minimum 75dpi., preferably landscape format (approx. 1200pixels wide) although we may be able to accommodate portrait.

Multimedia (moving image, audio)

Please include links to relevant material hosted on other sites eg. YouTube, Soundcloud.

Captions

All still and multimedia should be captioned, word limit per caption:18
